Fenland Open Meet 2016 - Rules of Competition

1. The Competition will be held under ASA Rules and Technical Rules and Regulations, Technical Rules of Racing and to the ASA Open Meet Licensing Criteria.
2. Age on the day of the competition 29th May 2016
3. This will be a Licensed Level 3 Meet with Colorado timing equipment managed by Fox Gala Timings.
4. The Competition will be held using over the top starts where safe to do so.
5. Entries will be processed electronically using Sportsys Meet Organisation Software. Entry into this competition implies acceptance that necessary data may be stored electronically. Sportsys entry files and instructions will be made available upon request.
6. The closing date is 3rd May 2016. Clubs are encouraged to submit electronic entries before the closing date. Electronic entries and supporting cheques must be received by midnight, 3rd May 2016. No entries will be accepted after the closing date. Once an entry is accepted by the promoters there will be no refund.
7. Entries are not considered accepted until payment has been received.
8. Entry fees, with entry summary form, should be sent to:

9. Cheques should be made payable to Fenland Open Meet. Clubs submitting block entries shall provide the Promoter a single cheque for the total amount to the above address.
10. All entrants must be members of an affiliated club and must be ASA CAT2 registered
11. Competitors can only enter events in their own age groups and in the name of one club.
12. Entry Fee £4.50 per Event.
13. The Promoters may limit the number of entries, which will be on a "first come first serve" basis.
14. Coaches passes are £8.00. This includes programme, food, results sheets and poolside pass which must be applied for before the closing date. Please indicate how many coaches passes will be required and submit fee along with return of competitor entries.
15. Winners will be heat declared.
16. Award for the first three in each age group. Any competitor disqualified will not receive an award. Point scoring will be 1st = 6 pts., 2nd = 5pts., 3rd = 4pts., 4th = 3pts., 5th = 2pts., 6th = 1 pt. Award for Top Boy and Girl in each age group. In the event of a tie a count back will take place on number of 1st place, 2nd place, etc. to determine the winner.
17. Competitors will be required to confirm their entry to the events by the use of **sign in sheets** located in the foyer and must be signed in at least **40 minutes** prior to the start of the session.
18. Competitors must report to the Marshalling stewards when requested, late reporting may result in exclusion of participating in the event.
19. The Pool area will be cleared between sessions.
20. Spectator Charges: £2.50 per session, £1.00 children and OAP's, All Day Event Programme £1.00.
21. All persons wishing to use photographic equipment - including mobile phones with image capturing facility - must register at the entrance desk.
22. Anything not covered by these rules will be at the discretion of the Promoters. who also reserve the right to make any changes that may be considered necessary for the smooth running and discipline of the event.
